Race Rules and General Information

Event Details:

- Race start at C (Main) and Union Streets.
- Pits on E Street, between Union and Sutton (between railroad museum and train depot).
- Vendors on E Street in *Silverland Hotel* parking lot.
- Scoring and finish line at E and Union Streets.
- Auction of # 0 and 00 to start ahead of Row 1 both days.
- Pre-order event shirt to be picked up with registration packet

Important Race Rules - Please Pay Note:

No pre-riding the race area. (Beginning Monday April 13, 2020)

- Observed violators will be disqualified (entry fees will not be refunded).

Course cutting will not be tolerated. Riders must stay within fifteen feet (15') of course markings at all times!

- 1st observed violation results in a 60-min time penalty; 2nd violation results in disqualification.

Pit Area – Strict controls will be in place:

- NO SMOKING!!! Dead engine fueling only!!! No children under age 12 in pit area.
- 5 mph max in pit area. No pets of any kind. No alcoholic beverages or glass containers.
- Each racer allowed a max of 2 support crew in pit; wristbands issued in signup packets and required for pit entry.
- All support crew in pit area must sign liability waiver and assume all risk of being in pits.
- Racers are responsible for pit crew conduct and will receive time penalties or DQ for any of their crew's misconduct.
- No race bike refueling is to take place outside of the formal pit area.

Transponder for scoring: MUST MATCH BIKE NUMBER! (Don't mix up transponders with your buddies.)

- Affixed under helmet visor and ensure no old transponders remain from past races.

Race Finish:

- Must start, compete and finish on the same bike.
- Must finish under *your* checkered flag (min 4 hours Sat and 3 hours Sun from your row's start time) for class & OA scoring and to receive a finisher pin.
- Results will be posted at race conclusion and racers have 20 minutes to present questions or protests to race officials.

General:

- Spark arrestors required and checked during <u>mandatory Tech Inspection</u>.
- All rule interpretations and enforcement, including assessment of rider penalties, are at the full discretion of the Race Director and the Race Marshal(s). All decisions are final.

Proper Etiquette while visiting VC and experiencing the Grand Prix:

We are privileged to be racing in Virginia City and need everyone to help ensure we are welcome here each year:

- Be considerate of VC residents: respect private property, keep the town clean and avoid noise concerns.
- Obey all local traffic laws, always wear a helmet and no two-up riding. Violators subject to citation and fine.
- No riding off-road motorcycles on C Street (except during official race start)
- No campfires permitted in Virginia City. Violators subject to citation and fine.
- Be courteous help maintain a positive image of racers and motorcycle enthusiasts.
- Tip your waitstaff in restaurants and bars to acknowledge their good service.
- And most of all, HAVE FUN AND ENJOY ANOTHER GREAT YEAR OF RACING ON THE COMSTOCK!!!
